

The Danish health care sector and core factors


- Universal, free and equal access

- expect good, public self-service solutions transparency and access to own data





Sundhed.dk is a user centered health universe creating value and coherence for both health professionals and citizens and support the empowerment of the citizens.









Citizens – access to personal data and information



Citizens log-in to the closed area From 2019 to 2021


